Paul Tilley was an economic policy adviser to governments for 30 years, working mainly in Treasury but also the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet, the Treasurer's Office, and the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development. He is a Visiting Fellow at the Australian National University's Tax and Transfer Policy Institute, and a Senior Fellow at the Melbourne Law School.

Paul is the author of two books. *Mixed Fortunes: A History of Tax Reform in Australia* examines the political economy

issues at stake in tax reform episodes and assesses the mixed quality of Australia's tax reforms. *Changing Fortunes: A History of the Australian Treasury* traces the institutional history of Treasury and examines the changing relationship between government and its public service advisers.
